

Rules Of Play For 4-27-2014 LAGA MODIFIED STABLEFORD

1. This tournament will be conducted in a Modified Stableford format. This means that you are given points for the scores that you make on each hole. At the end of the round the player with the highest point total will win. Points will be given as follows: Par = +1, Birdie = +2, Eagle = +4, Double Eagle = +8, Bogey = -1, Double Bogey or more = -2. Your handicap will be applied to your scores as your handicap strokes appear on the scorecard. If you make a par on a hole that you receive a stroke on, you will net a birdie and be scored as +2. Conversely, if you make a net bogey, you will score the hole as -1. **Please write down your gross score for each hole.** Understand that your final score for the tournament is NOT your stroke total, but the POINT total. **Men and women will play from the white tees.**
2. **Scores will be posted so each player needs to play out every hole and write down your gross score.** The tournament committee and computer will determine your MODIFIED STABLEFORD points.
3. **You may bump the ball in your own fairway.**
4. Ties will split the prize money for the tied positions. Payoffs will be to over 40% of the field.
5. All local rules as published by LAGA are in effect. Any question about a rule, either get a ruling from the tournament committee or play the hole out with two balls and report to the tournament committee after play.
